



Staffing Employees Bridge to Permanent Jobs



The 2014 ASA Staffing Employee Survey was conducted among 11,969 current (64%) and former (36%) temporary or contract employees who had worked for one of 275 staffing companies on or after Jan. 1, 2013.

Staffing employees have many motivations for choosing temporary or contract work. The most common reason, cited by one-half (49%) of the survey respondents, is that "It's a way to get a permanent job."

- Nearly 90% of temporary and contract employees say that staffing work made them more employable.
- One-half (49%) say that staffing employment helped them get their foot in the door for a permanent job.
- One-third (34%) of temporary and contract employees were offered permanent positions by a client firm where they had worked on assignment—two-thirds (66%) of those accepted the offers of employment.
